



About the FIA Performance Factor website

Welcome to the FIA Performance Factor (hereinafter "Pf") website.

There are two ways to access it:

• <u>"Public" access</u>

The "Public" access is open to everyone and does not require registration.

It enables the **Pf** of a car's configuration to be calculated. It is not possible to save your configurations nor obtain an **FIA-PF-ID** via the "Public" access.

• <u>"Competitor" access</u>

The Competitor access requires (free) registration and offers a set of functions not available via the "Public" access.

A virtual garage enables you to:

- register one or more cars;
- simulate, compare and save technical configurations;
- create several technical configurations and calculate the **Pf** for each of the registered cars;
- calculate the **Pf** and generate an **FIA-PF-ID**.

Prior to all FIA European Hill Climb Championship (season 2019) competitions, the drivers and competitors of Category 1 (Groups A, N, S20 and GT) and Group E2-SH of Category 2 are required to fill out the technical form via the Competitor access and to obtain:

- the **Pf** (the performance factor value);
- an **FIA-PF-ID** (a six-digit identification code).

This data is specific to the technical configuration of the car being entered in the FIA Championship competition. They must be declared to the organiser via the entry form in order to determine the classification of the car.

During scrutineering, conformity with the declared configuration will be checked.

In 2019, this procedure is being trialled and aims to explain the methodology applied by the FIA. It will not have an impact on the FIA European Hill Climb Championship from a sporting or regulatory standpoint.
